



## SAMPLING STRATEGY

*WP3 “Characterisation of biological indicators to assess the beneficial effects of forest interventions on human health and well-being”*



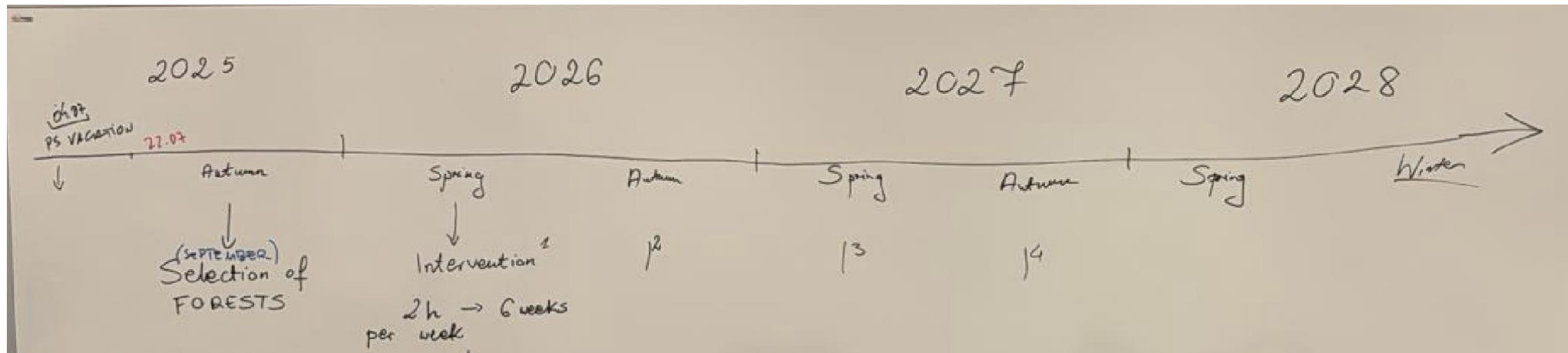
*“To allow a better general picture of each ecosystem, the sampling strategy involves selecting **five different forests** of the types above mentioned, with **five sites per forest** (see designated areas from WP2) to sample and collect small portions of soil throughout the forest (**along the walking path for NCA/FTHub intervention**) to be analyzed for different parameters (microbiome, both fungal and bacterial community, and needles and air samples for BVOCs).*
